This letter of agreement is for the purpose of establishing the use of camp property by _____

2. _____ agrees to provide the following documents that are
required by the Texas Trails Council BSA at least 10 days prior to event.

- a) A certificate of liability insurance with a minimum of \$1,000,000 CSL with the Texas Trails Council, Boy Scouts of America, and the National Council, Boy Scouts of America, named as additional insured, ten (10) day written notice of cancellation, and the period of time involved.
- b) A hold harmless agreement. (see back of form)
- c) A certificate showing non-profit and/or tax exempt status.
- d) A roster showing the names of all youth and adults participating in this activity.

3. It is understood and agreed to by both parties that the fee for the use of property is \$ _____

4. It is understood and agreed to by both parties that a deposit of \$100.00 is required to be paid by (date) _____ . This is refundable, if rental property and facilities are left clean and no damage occurred.

5. It is understood and agreed to by both parties that _____ shall be responsible for any and all damages to camp property which may reasonably be attributed to the actions of, said group and _____ agrees to promptly pay any and all reasonable damage claims when presented.

6. It is understood and agreed by both parties that no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs of any kind are permitted to be used on these premises.

7. It is understood and agreed by both parties that _____ will provide at least one adult leader (defined as 21 years of age or older for purposes herein) for every ten (10) members of the party present in camp below the age of 21 years; that at least one of the said adult leaders must be present with the group at all times while the group is in camp.

8. It is understood and agreed to by both parties that the group will abide by any and all of the camp operating rules as outlined on the attached sheet and directions and instructions of the Camp Ranger.

9. It is further understood and agreed to by both parties that should the group fail to provide proper leadership or fail to abide by camp rules or directions of the Camp Ranger, the Texas Trails Council Camp Ranger may in his discretion terminate this agreement and require the renting parties to vacate the camp, forfeiting any and all fees and moneys agreed to herein.
