REGULATIONS FOR USE OF TEXAS TRAILS PROPERTIES

1 Check-in & Check-out

- Check-in with proper council representative
- Be prepared to show required documentation camp permit, tour permit, and any other information asked for
- All campsites, equipment, and facilities will be checked before departure for damage, misuse, and cleanliness
- Any lost or damaged equipment or vandalism to property will be paid before you depart camp.
- Cleanliness of camp and facilities is user responsibility

2 Vehicles

- Speed limit is 10mph on all camp properties unless otherwise posted
- All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas only, equipment trailer may remain in campsite
- Do not enter campsite with any motor vehicle for any reason
- Riding in the bed of trucks is not allowed

3 Camp Boundaries

- Stay with-in camp boundaries
- Trespassing is illegal and in violation of Scout Law
- Adult leader must accompany any activity of camp property

4 Campfires

- Fires in designated fire rings only
- Use only dead wood, do not cut down trees
- Do not dig holes for fires
- Make sure fires are completely out and ashes spread

5 Liquid Fuel Use

- White gas or other flammable material for adult use only
- Youth campers may use LP gas only when necessary
- All liquid fuels must be kept by camp or in unit's designated storage facility

6 Program Areas

- Swimming pool- use is subject to the discretion of the Camp Ranger

Adult must have Waterfront Permit completed before use
All participants must follow all rules and regulations set by BSA and Texas Trails Council

Must have trained lifeguards on duty at all times while the pool is in use

- **Archery range**- Must have an adult (21 years or older) to supervise the use of the range and they must be in attendance at a times

Care of equipment is user's responsibility

Damage to equipment will be paid at checkout

- **Rifle Range**- Must have an adult (21 years or older) with BSA Shooting Sports Certification in attendance at all times while on the range

Must have Rifle Range Permit completed before use

No unauthorized weapons will be allowed

All participants and staff must follow the rules

Care of equipment is user's responsibility

Damage to equipment will be paid at checkout

- **Shotgun Range**- Must have an adult (21 years or older) with BSA Shooting Sports Certification in attendance at all times while on the range

Must have Shotgun Range Permit completed before use

No unauthorized weapons will be allowed

All participants and staff must follow the rules

Care of equipment is user's responsibility

Damage to equipment will be paid at checkout

- **COPE Area**- off limits without certified cope instructor present

- **Climbing and Repelling Tower** - off limits without certified instructor present

- **Natural Climbing and Repelling wall** -off limits without certified instructor present

7 Alcohol, Tobacco, Fireworks

- Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed and is grounds for immediate dismissal
- Tobacco products are not allowed in camping areas or program areas, their use is limited to designated areas
- Illegal drug use is not permitted and will result in immediate dismissal
- Fireworks are not allowed on council properties, possession will result in immediate dismissal
