Sign in will be at 7:00 p.m. for Elongomats and 8:00 p.m. for candidates and members on Friday night at Beaver Lodge. Also the nomination and election of the officers for the next year will take place on Sunday morning. (New officers take over their responsibilities at the banquet in August.)
